Current Series: In This House

1 Timothy is a letter that is written by the apostle Paul to Timothy, who Paul calls, "My true son in the faith." It is a letter from a father to a son, in the sense that Paul the apostle writes to Timothy, the pastor to instruct, advise, and inspire him to fulfill his calling before God. As we see a young man in the faith receive this instruction, we see a picture of what it means to dedicate our lives to the calling God has placed on each of us.

Most scholars believe that the key verses of 1 Timothy are in chapter 3, verses 14-15. They say, "Although I hope to come to you soon, I am writing you these instructions so that, if I am delayed, you will know how people ought to conduct themselves in God's household, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and foundation of the truth." At the center of this letter is a message about how people are meant to conduct themselves in the church of Jesus Christ.

³ As I urged you when I went into Macedonia, stay there in Ephesus so that you may command certain people not to teach false doctrines any longer ⁴ or to devote themselves to myths and endless genealogies. Such things promote controversial speculations rather than advancing God's work—which is by faith.

Is the ending point _____ or _____ ?

⁵ The goal of this command is love, which comes from a pure heart and a good conscience and a sincere faith. ⁶ Some have departed from these and have turned to meaningless talk. ⁷ They want to be teachers of the law, but they do not know what they are talking about or what they so confidently affirm. ⁸ We know that the law is good if one uses it properly. ⁹ We also know that the law is made not for the righteous but for lawbreakers and rebels, the ungodly and sinful, the unholy and irreligious, for those who kill their fathers or mothers, for murderers, ¹⁰ for the sexually immoral, for those practicing homosexuality, for slave traders and liars and perjurers—and for whatever else is contrary to the sound doctrine ¹¹ that conforms to the gospel concerning the glory of the blessed God, which he entrusted to me.
